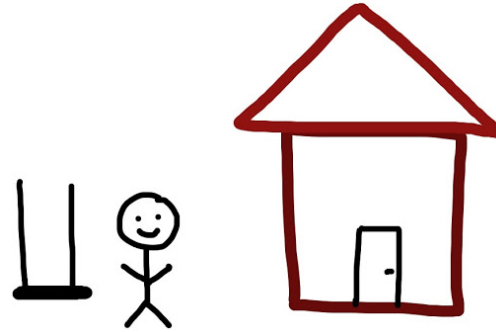


You in a Place

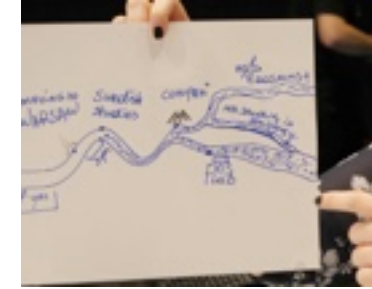
Creating Stories



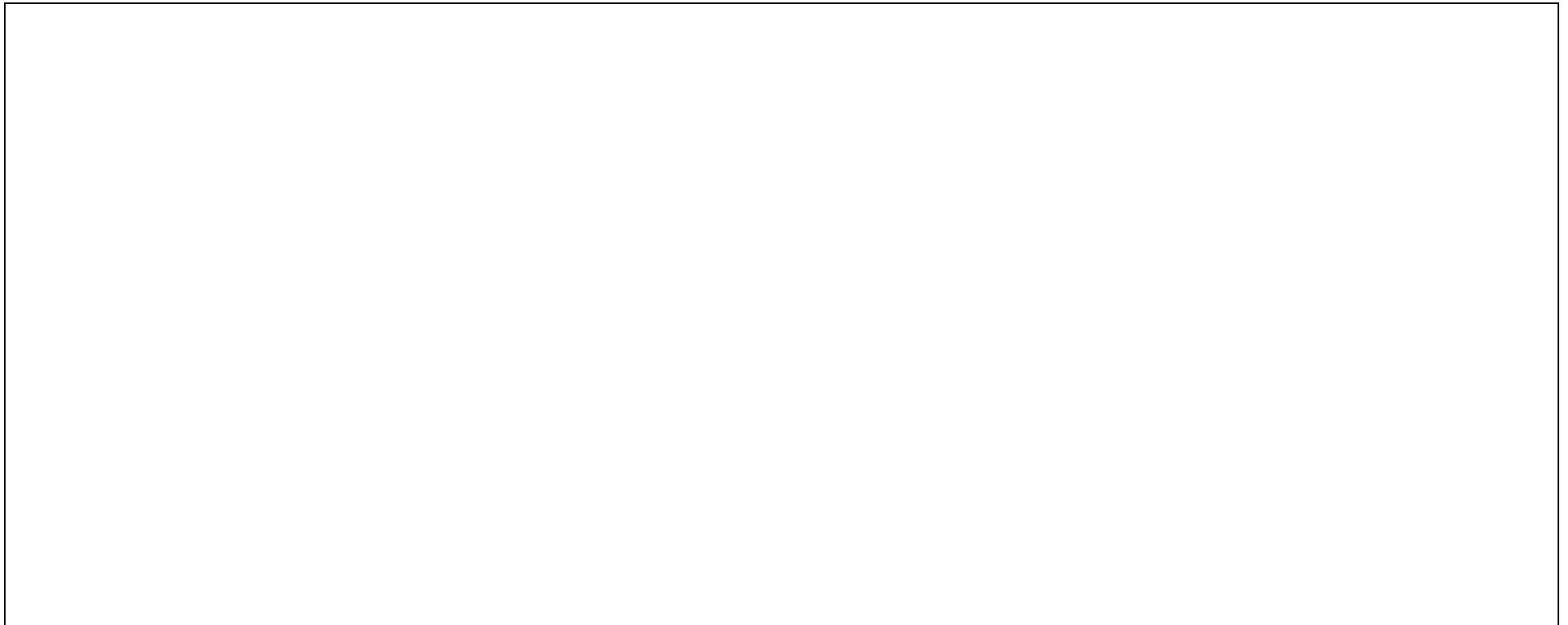
Using story cubes:
